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## Student Admissions Policy and Procedure

## 1 Preliminaries

## Commencement

1.1 This policy and procedure commenced on 1 April 2024

## Purpose

1.2 This policy and procedure outlines how and when the Australian Guild of Education ("AGE") upholds the principle that all applicants seeking to enrol are treated fairly and equitably. To ensure this, AGE will have open, fair, clear and transparent procedures that are based on clearly defined entry criteria for making decisions about the admission of students. Students will be admitted on merit, based on the published criteria and AGE will ensure that throughout the process of admission, applicants are treated courteously and expeditiously.

## Application

1.3 This policy and procedure document applies to all students at AGE, and to all staff involved in the admissions process.

## 2 Definitions

The following definitions apply in this document:
ATAR means the Australian Tertiary Admission Rank.
AQF means the Australian Qualifications Framework.
Admissions Officer means an AGE staff member that evaluates applications from prospective students interested in attending AGE and responsible for handling AGE's intake, processing, evaluation and determinations of submitted applications.

## 3 Policy Statement

## Approach

3.1 As a Higher Education Provider, AGE has open, fair and transparent procedures that are based on merit, for making decisions about the approval of applicants who seek to enrol with the Institute in a unit of study. Applicants seeking to enrol in a course of study with AGE, regardless of their background, circumstances or eligibility for funding, will be assessed for entry to study through the same published entry requirements and through the same process. Specific consideration will be given to intending students from an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders (ATSI) background.
3.2 In making decisions about the approval of applicants for admission, the above undertakings do not prevent AGE from taking into account educational disadvantages that a particular applicant has experienced, or the fact that the applicant may be enrolled via a restricted access arrangement.

## Publication

3.3 Entry criteria and application procedures are published in the Course Guides and on AGE's website for the information of persons seeking to enrol with the Institute.

## 4 Responsibilities

## General Entry Requirements

4.1 All applicants seeking to enrol in a course with AGE are required to submit acceptable evidence that meets the published entry criteria for their chosen course.

## Undergraduate

4.2 To satisfy the general entrance requirements for admission to a course, applicants must meet at least one of the following entry requirements:
a. Successful completion of an Australian senior secondary qualification (or recognised equivalent).
b. Successful completion of a qualification at an Australian registered institution of tertiary education, at AQF Level 5 or above (or recognised equivalent issued in a country listed Appendix 2); or
c. Satisfactory completion of an accredited Tertiary Preparation Program or Foundation Year Program offered by an Australian university that enables students to gain entry to an Australian university;
4.3 To satisfy the additional general entrance requirements for admission to the Bachelor of Music Degree, applicants must meet the following entry requirements:
a. The applicant must supply:

A Music Theory Document: a Graded Examinations Music Theory Certificate (Grade $4 / 5$ or above) - only the highest level attained is to be submitted. The Certificate must be from an OFQUAL regulated examination board or an equivalent level examination board.
OR
Equivalent Skills Assessment: the AGE Music Theory Skills Assessment must be passed with no less than a 65\% pass mark.
AND AGE Theory Assessment.
b. Performance Document or Equivalent Skills Assessment or Interview: Graded Examination Instrumental Certificate (Highest Level Only) e.g. Grade 7, ATCL etc or , Practical Performance skills Assessment AND
Recorded Audition of 6-9 minutes demonstrating at least three contrasting styles. These may be parts of works.
c. All students must be 18 years of age or over at the time that they commence the course for which they have applied.
4.4 In addition to the general entry requirements, admission to the specialisation electives requires applicants to satisfy the following specific requirements.

## Composition Specialisation

a. Curriculum Vitae specific to Composition, Music Production, or Arranging OR Composition Folio of at least 2 original musical works, 5-10 minutes in duration, demonstrating 2 contrasting styles reflective of contemporary practice.

## Teaching (Pedagogy) Specialisation

b. A minimum practical instrumental standard of an OFQUAL regulated Grade 6/7 or the equivalent thereof on the primary instrument.

## Performance Specialisation

c. A minimum practical instrumental standard of an OFQUAL regulated Grade 7 or the equivalent thereof
4.5 Where an applicant elects to do multiple streams, it is expected that the applicant meets both the specific entry requirements in addition to the general entry requirements. This option is only available to domestic students.
4.6 Where there are higher education studies in addition to completed vocational qualifications, the decision for admission will solely be based on the higher education academic results.

## English Language Proficiency Requirements - Undergraduate

4.7 Students whose first language is not English, must demonstrate competency in the English language. English proficiency can be demonstrated by providing certified evidence of an International English Language Testing System (IELTS) test result (or equivalent alternative test result as listed below), issued no more than two (2) years prior to the date of application:

Note that the most recent attempt at any language proficiency test supersedes any previous attempts (irrespective of those test results) or requirements.
4.8 Other acceptable evidence of English proficiency includes the successful completion of an AQF Level 5 Diploma or above with at least one (1) year of full-time study in English at an Australian registered vocational or higher education provider.
4.9 Applicants who do not meet the specified English proficiency requirements must enrol in an English Language Intensive Courses for Overseas Students (ELICOS) program at a provider of their own choice.
4.10 Where students have applied to undertake an ELICOS course through an external provider, they must provide a Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) for an ELICOS program in English for Academic Purposes (EAP), for a duration of at least twelve (12) weeks for every 0.5 below 6.0 overall or subsection IELTS or equivalent result, prior to application, and evidence of successful completion must be provided prior to enrolling in the AGE course.
4.11 All evidence must show that test results have been officially obtained within two (2) years of the proposed commencement date of the course.

## Advanced Standing/Credit/Recognition of Prior Learning

4.12 Students may apply for Advanced Standing or Credit for Prior Learning at the time of admission. All applications are assessed under the provisions of the Credit and Recognition of Prior Learning Policy and Procedure.

## Special/Alternative Admission Arrangements - Undergraduate

4.13 Applicants who are 21 years of age or over who have not completed Year 12 or its equivalent may gain entry to a course by addressing one of the following entry requirements:
a. Successful completion of a Special Tertiary Admissions Test administered by a tertiary admissions centre; or
b. Submission of a portfolio of prior and current academic and professional work; or
c. Applicants applying under special admission categories will be required to attend an interview with the Dean to assess the applicant's capacity for higher education studies. The applicant is requested to submit a portfolio of prior and current academic and professional work prior to the interview to assist in the assessment process.
4.14 The Academic Director utilises the following criteria when approving applicants for admission into a course under special or alternative admission arrangements:
a. capacity to pursue tertiary studies;
b. motivation to pursue tertiary studies in the discipline of the chosen course;
c. demonstrated potential for academic studies based on the applicant's portfolio;
d. relevant professional and industry experience; and
e. specific consideration of access issues for ATSIs.
4.15 The processes used to monitor the progress of students enrolled under special/alternative arrangements include:
a. monitoring of the student's progress by AGE's Learning and Teaching Committee at the conclusion of each term in the first year of the student's enrolment; and
b. a "Review of Student Progress" meeting between the student and AGE's Learning and Teaching Committee at the conclusion of the first semester of the student's enrolment to review the student's academic progression and their welfare.

## 5 Applications

5.1 Applications for admission to a course shall be made by completion and lodgement of all relevant sections on AGE's prescribed form.

## Assessment of Applications and Verification of Evidence

5.2 All applications for admission to a course will be assessed by a qualified Admissions Officer.
5.2 Applicants who apply to undertake a course of study at AGE must submit documentary evidence that demonstrates they meet the published entry requirements for their chosen course. Certified copies of all documentation must be provided, or original documents can be sighted and certified by the Admissions Officer.
5.3 Qualifications submitted in a language other than English must be accompanied by a certified official English translation.
5.4 Where there is any doubt about the authenticity of any documentation provided, the Admissions Officer must correspond with the issuer of the document and make relevant enquiries.
5.5 All applications and their assessment will be validated by the Dean. The process for assessing applications is attached as Appendix 1.

## Offers

5.6 Subject to the application meeting the published entry criteria and documentation provided, a written offer in the course will be made to the applicant via a Student Offer and Acceptance Agreement. Any conditions of the offer will be detailed in this agreement.

## Acceptance

5.7 Applicants accept an offer of a place in a course by signing and returning a copy of the Student Offer and Acceptance Agreement as directed. Acceptance of an offer of a place shall be taken to constitute acceptance by the applicant of all of AGE's published policies and procedures.
5.8 Once an offer is accepted, the applicant is enrolled in their chosen course and sent a Confirmation of Enrolment (COE) letter with details about the course and arrangements for student orientation.

## Cancellation of Enrolment

5.9 A student's enrolment may be cancelled in accordance with AGE's Student Deferment, Suspension and Cancellation of Study Policy and Procedure.

## Appeals

5.10 An applicant may appeal against a decision to refuse admission to a course as set out in AGE's Student Grievance Handling Policy and Procedure.

- Finalise documentation

Application unsuccessful:

- Advise applicant of outcome of application and right to appeal decision
