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## Scholarships for Students

The Guild awards a number of annual scholarships. These awards are made on the basis of skills achieved prior to commencing the VET program.

Scholarships and honorary awards are awarded on the basis of merit for students and individuals.

### AGME Scholarship Conditions

Scholarships are created by the Guild for students studying or about to enrol at AGME and are awarded on the basis of merit. Students must display at least one of the criteria listed below. The number of scholarships may be limited by AGME, and therefore demonstration of the scholarship criteria does not automatically mean that a scholarship will be granted.

### Scholarship criteria

The following will be contingent on the VET course level:

- a high level of performance skills
- has been recommended by an AGME - registered teacher for expertise in performance, theory and aural. (evidence required)
- high pass in English
- demonstration of a number of professional public performances
- an AGME - registered teacher
- high results in a VET course.

The merit of the student is reviewed each semester. A student's scholarship will be paid upon the successful completion of a semester and the approved results from the Faculty Board. The Faculty Board meets to determine the results for a student, and that all scholarship conditions have been met.

AGME scholarships are awarded subject to the following conditions:

- Holders must not receive a fail grade for any unit of study;
- Holders must achieve at least one or more grades of Distinction
- Holders are to contribute to public performance activities for AGME where requested
- Holders are to refrain from any academic misconduct

Failure to meet any of the above conditions may result in the scholarship holder receiving a cancellation of their scholarship. The scholarship holder will receive notification before a scholarship is cancelled to give the opportunity to present their case towards keeping their scholarship. If a student accepts the scholarship, then the conditions are also being accepted.

To be eligible for one of the following scholarships, students will be required to sit a performance audition, a music-theory test and supply any supporting documentation.

All decisions made by the Scholarships Selection Committee are final. No correspondence will be entered into. All scholarships are paid in the form of a reduction on the annual course fees. They are not transferable or redeemable for cash. Should a scholarship recipient leave the Guild before completing the course, the scholarship will be forfeited. The Committee may exercise discretion in the awarding of scholarships and may decide not to nominate any student for a particular award. Final decisions will be communicated to both successful and unsuccessful candidates.
